**What would you like to FOCUS ON or IMPLEMENT during your biennium?**

### ➡ Focus on Membership

1. Increasing our chapter membership
2. Bringing in 1-2 new members
3. Membership retention
4. Using "membership" strategies to interest new members
5. Increasing membership by recruiting active teachers

### ➡ Focus on Supporting/Learning about Sisters/Sisterhood

1. Implementing "Spotlight on a Sister" - getting to know fellow sisters on a more personal level.
2. "Sisterhood in Action": nurturing relationships between sisters and supporting collaboration among sisters.
3. Continuing to share and care for each other.
4. Continuing to encourage members to fulfill our "responsibility" to not only bring in a new member but support one another in all areas.
5. Encouraging camaraderie within our chapter: making connections and building community.
6. Strengthening emotional bonds and relationships among sisters.
7. Improving communication amongst sisters.

### ➡ Focus on Altruism

1. Brainstorming new volunteer opportunities.
2. Increasing service projects to 2-3 per year.
3. Focusing on Ronald McDonald House of Charities as our altruistic project for the biennium.
4. Participating in more altruistic projects.
5. Concentrating on the "aina" for service projects.

### ➡ Focus on Earning 7 Pearls of Achievement

1. Striving to earn 7 Pearls of Achievement
2. Meeting international and HADK deadlines and receiving 7 Pearls of Achievement.

## ➡ Focus on Meetings

1. Increasing attendance at nine (9) meetings.
2. Conducting fraternity education activities i.e. team-building games.
3. Spotlighting "E Ola Pono"- Living a Healthy Lifestyle; being healthy means being an effective leader which leads to having effective meetings.
4. Scheduling 'fun' meetings and events.
5. Having meetings at restaurants and keeping them short!
6. Infusing fun, excitement, and pride whenever possible in activities, meetings, and altruistic events.
7. Conducting efficient meetings.

## ➡ Focus on Members

1. Continuing focus on active educators (engagement) as they are tomorrow's leaders; mentoring them may help.
2. Keeping ALL members (new and senior) involved.
3. Finding ways to assist and involve older members and members who do not attend meetings.
4. Helping especially "newer" members to have a sense of belonging, inclusiveness.
